**PART 1 - PRELIMINARY**

**Title**

1. This policy may be cited as Local Law Policy No. 4 (Regulated Parking).

**Commencement**

3. This policy commences on 27.11.97.

**PART 2 - REGULATION OF PARKING**

*Division 1 - Traffic Areas*

**Declaration of Traffic Areas (LL section 4)**

4. The part of the area of the City of Warwick described in the Schedule hereto is the declared traffic area and is assigned the name of the Warwick Traffic Area.

**SCHEDULE  
WARWICK TRAFFIC AREA**

The road areas of the following Streets:-

Palmerin Street	-	both sides between Percy Street and Albert Street
Palmerin Street	-	eastern side only between Albert and Victoria Streets
King Street	-	both sides between Palmerin Street and Albion Street
Grafton Street	-	both sides between Guy Street and Albion Street
Fitzroy Street	-	both sides between Guy Street and Albion Street

**Regulation of Parking in Declared Traffic Areas (LL Section 5)**

5.
  - (1) A person will not park a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, in a designated parking space for a period of more than two (2) hours at any one time during the hours of the days designated on the sign.

- (2) The times and days when the above restriction applies in the Declared Traffic Area are from eight o'clock in the morning to five o'clock in the afternoon (8.00am to 5.00pm), Monday to Friday (Statutory holidays excepted), and eight o'clock in the morning to twelve o'clock noon (8.00am to 12.00 noon) Saturday (Statutory holidays excepted).
- (3) A person will not park a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle or a commercial vehicle in a designated parking space designated by an official traffic sign to be a loading zone or a disabled persons parking space between the times and on the days as specified in (1) and (2) above.

### ***Division 2 - Regulated Parking Areas (LL section 8)***

6.
  - (1) A person will not park a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, within the regulated parking area otherwise than in a marked parking space as designated for that purpose on the road area as specified in the schedule as the Warwick Traffic Area.
  - (2) The local government will define and maintain a marking system on the road pavement to indicate the confines of a designated parking space.
  - (3) A person will not park a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, in a designated parking space within the Regulated Parking area otherwise than in accordance with an official traffic sign.
  - (4) The local government will install official traffic signs within the regulated parking area to indicate a designated parking space as a loading zone or a disabled persons parking space.

## **PART 3 - LOADING ZONES**

### ***Division 1 - Loading Zones (LL section 14)***

#### **Loading zones**

7.
  - (1) The local government will designate parking spaces within the regulated parking area as Loading Zones by way of official traffic signs.

### ***Division 2 - Issue of Commercial Vehicle Identification Labels (LL section 16)***

#### **Issue of commercial vehicle identification labels (LL section 16)**

8.
  - (1) The local government may upon receipt of the prescribed application form for the issue of a commercial vehicle identification label, and payment of a fee fixed from time to time by resolution of the Council issue a identification label if it is satisfied that the vehicle is a commercial vehicle within the meaning of the *Traffic Act 1949*.

## **PART 5 - LOCAL GOVERNMENT PARKING PERMITS**

### **Issue of parking permits (LL section 20)**

9.

- (1) A person may make application to the local government on the prescribed form for a parking permit to occupy a parking space in the regulated parking area for a period in excess of the time specified on an official traffic sign or contrary to an indication given by an official traffic sign.
- (2) The Chief Executive Officer or an authorised person of the local government may grant a parking permit upon lodgement of the prescribed form and payment of a permit fee to occupy for a specified occasion or specified term such number of parking spaces as may be specified in the parking permit.
- (3) The fee for a parking permit will be as fixed by resolution of the local government from time to time.

### **Classes of persons to whom permits may be issued (LL Section 21)**

10.

- (1) The local government will only consider an application for a parking permit from a person representing or acting on behalf of:
  - (a) a local charitable organisation, service club or sporting association; or
  - (b) a person representing an association or organisation who holds a current authority issued by the Art Unions Division Queensland Treasury to conduct an Art Union.
